Trailers

Parking in Streets

Race Route & Lanes

- South on all lanes of Olio Road
- West and South on all lanes of Springstone
- West on westbound lanes of 96th Street

Traffic Exit Route & Lanes

- Springstone Rd (both directions) will be closed from 7:30am until approximately 8:40am. There MAY be a 10 minute time period from from approximately 7:50-8:00am when traffic will be allowed to exit east on Springstone, between the start of the half marathon and 5K events.
- Olio Road will be closed from Springstone north to 116th Street from 7:20am until approximately 8:30am. Thereafter, Olio Road will be fully open (north and south) and 96th St. will be open east of Springstone.
- 96th Street between Springstone & Fall Creek Road will be closed westbound from 7:30-9:30am.
- Fall Creek between 96th & Bridgewater will reopen after 9:30am.
